

# BERUFSREIFEPRÜFUNG ENGLISCH - THEMENPOOL

## GRUNDLAGE

„Die Bildungseinrichtungen (öffentliche Schulen bzw Erwachsenenbildungseinrichtungen) haben mindestens zwölf Themenkreise für ihren spezifischen Standort festzulegen. Jeder Themenkreis kann selbstverständlich aus der Perspektive der jeweiligen Schulart behandelt werden. Auf den Schultyp bezogene Erweiterungen der Liste sind möglich, die Gesamtanzahl der Themenkreise sollte dabei fünfzehn nicht überschreiten.“<sup>1</sup>

TOPICS	Selected Aspects
ADDICTION AND DEPENDENCE	socially accepted drugs, illegal drugs, shopping, gambling, Internet, sex, remedies, obsessions, stalking
ART	forms of art, art history, art in the ice age, graffiti, film, music
BEAUTY	definition of beauty, concepts of beauty over time, beauty in different cultures, plastic surgery, beauty pageants
CRIME AND VIOLENCE	shooting sprees, gun control, death penalty, domestic violence, violence and media, terrorism, forms of bullying (cyber bullying, mobile bullying), teenage suicide (Jamey Rodemeyer), "It gets better."
EDUCATION	school systems, forms of education, forms of evaluation, career planning, homeschooling, unschooling, college education
ENVIRONMENT AND POLLUTION	recycling, acid rain, drinking water, smog, traffic, urbanization, (alternative) forms of energy, global warming, climate change, rainforests, desertification, footprints, saving energy, Kyoto
FOOD AND NUTRITION	eating disorders, obesity, organic farming, fast food, GM food, dieting, nutritional values
GENDER ISSUES	historic gender roles, stereotypes, emancipation, equal opportunity, equal pay day

LINKED	world wide web, virtual worlds, gaming, social networks, identity thieves, chat rooms, online dating, online shopping, cyber bullying, Wikipedia, knowledge is/was power
SCIENCE	cloning, stem cell research, robots, limits in science, genetic engineering, inventions, science fiction, discoveries, technology
SOCIAL TIES	family (generation gap, growing up, love and marriage, divorce, mail order brides, child marriage, gay marriage, parenting, role models, forms of the family, functions of the family), friends (peer pressure, teenage issues)
TOLERANCE	minorities, outsiders, racism, discrimination, homosexuality
TOPICAL ISSUES	Current news and issues, major events worldwide
TRAVEL AND TOURISM	means of transport, air travel, destinations, kinds of tourism, traveler and tourist, eco tourism, tourism and environment, slum tourism
